

## Section Amendment to Current By Law #A-01

### BY LAW NO. A-01

**A By Law Relating to the Proceedings of the Council of the Village of Plaster Rock is hereby amended under the noted Sections:**

#### **1. Definitions**

“Act” means the Local Governance

“Procedural by-law” means a by-law enacted pursuant to section 10(2 a) of the Act

“clerk” means a clerk appointed pursuant to Section 74 of the Local Governance Act

#### **2. Meetings of Council**

(3) Subject to the Local Governance Act, council shall hold its Regular (Public) Meetings on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Mondays of each month, at a time to be determined by council. In the event that Monday is a holiday, the meeting shall be held on the Tuesday of that week. The Agenda of the said meeting shall be circulated on the preceding Friday.

(4) Council as per Section 48 of the Local Governance Act shall elect a Deputy Mayor from within Council. The Councillor with the majority number of votes shall be appointed Deputy Mayor. The election of the Deputy Mayor shall be held at the first meeting of council and shall serve for the duration of the 4 year term.

(7) a) Council shall hold closed meetings of council, to be called at the discretion of the Mayor or upon written petition of any three members of Council, when the subject matter of the meeting includes any of the following as stated under section 68(1) a) to j) of the Local Governance Act

- information of which the confidentiality is protected by law,
- personal information as defined in the *Right to Information and Protection of Privacy Act*,
- information that could cause financial loss or gain to a person or the local government or could jeopardize negotiations leading to an agreement or contract,
- the proposed or pending acquisition or disposition of land,

- information that could violate the confidentiality of information obtained from the Government of Canada or from the government of a province or territory,
- information concerning legal opinions or advice provided to the local government by its solicitor or privileged communications between solicitor and client in a matter of local government business,
- litigation or potential litigation affecting the local government or any corporation referred to in subsection 8(1), the local government’s agencies, boards or commissions including a matter before an administrative tribunal,
- the access to or security of buildings and other structures occupied or used by the local government or access to or security of systems of the local government, including computer or communication systems,
- information gathered by the police, including the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, in the course of investigating any illegal activity or suspected illegal activity, or the source of that information,
- labour and employment matters, including the negotiation of collective agreements.
